


Dinner location and transport details

One of the many (nice) footpath to the restaurant



Coming by bus – three lines at your doorstep

- Bus 27 (in blue) from station VIII Agosto to station Torleone
- Bus 11 (in grey, following the blue line at the beginning) from station VIII Agosto to station Garganelli
- Bus C (in grey, first line to go on the right) from station VIII Agosto to station Garganelli
